



St. Michael's Hospice Accumulator Challenge Terms and Conditions

- The £50 provided is a loan from St. Michael's Hospice and must be returned at the end of the challenge when all money raised is paid in.
- The £50 loan will be given in cash to the assigned team leader on the 2nd September at the Presentation Evening. The team leader will need to complete and sign a form to say this has been received and they personally agree to pay this loan back to the Hospice, regardless of the total sum made from the challenge.
- All money raised from the challenge, including the £50 loan, must be paid to St. Michael's Hospice by Wednesday 11th December 2019. Preferably, money would be paid directly into our bank account using your team name as the reference. If you plan to hand us the money by cheque or cash, please contact Laura Holmes on 01256 848846 first.
- You agree to only conduct your fundraising between 2nd September – 2nd December in line with when the challenge runs. Anyone found to be fundraising for the challenge outside of this window will not be eligible to receive an award and excluded from attending the Accumulator Challenge Awards evening.
