

Payroll Giving or Give As You Earn (GAYE)

How it works

The regular donation leaves your salary before the tax is calculated. Therefore you do not pay tax on your contribution. As an added incentive the Government agree to add a further 10% to all payroll giving. Please see the table set out below as a guide for your convenience.

Amount	How much it will cost you based upon 22% tax	How much it will cost you based upon 40% tax	The amount St Michael's Hospice will receive
£1	78p	60p	£1.10
£5	£3.90	£3.00	£5.50
£10	£7.80	£6.00	£11.00
£20	£15.60	£12.00	£22.00
