

Virtual Big Wheel Terms and Conditions

- Any participants completing our Virtual Big Wheel cycles under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult aged 18+.
- Entry fee is non-refundable.
- Virtual Big Wheel can be completed on any form of bike but this excludes motorised bikes.
- If the participant decides to design their own route, they are responsible for ensuring their chosen route is safe and legal.
- Upon registering for our Virtual Big Wheel challenges, each participant agrees they are physically fit and mentally capable of cycling the distance they have chosen and are responsible for their own medical condition. If the participant is in any doubt about their health or has a medical condition that could be affected by the challenge, they must seek their doctor's approval first. Participants take part at their own risk.
- St. Michael's Hospice cannot be held responsible for personal accident, injury, loss or damage occurred during the event. Each participant will be fully responsible for any fees or costs incurred or arising from an accident either involving or caused by the rider.
- St. Michael's Hospice does not accept responsibility for the actions of participants.
- St. Michael's Hospice strongly advises all participants to take out their own insurance to cover themselves for all aspects of their cycle.
- All participants choosing to complete their Virtual Big Wheel challenge on public highways and footpaths must follow the Highway Code. Traffic signals and road signs must also be obeyed.
- If you are unable to complete your Virtual Big Wheel challenge, we kindly ask you to let us know at your earliest convenience.
- It is mandatory all cyclists wear an approved safety helmet if completing their cycle on public highways and footpaths.
- Participants must track their route through a distance tracking app, taking a picture of the mileage completed or keeping a log of the mileage using our paper tracker.
- If you are completing the Virtual 100, you must send us your proof of cycle before we will send your commemorative medal.
- If you are completing the Cycle Your Way virtual challenge, you must send us proof of your cycle and raise a minimum of £30 before receiving your medal.
- Any participants who raise £100 + will be entitled to receive the mystery gift.

- All sponsorship money must be sent to St. Michael's Hospice (North Hampshire) by Friday 27th September 2019.
