## Top tips to get you started!

Set yourself a target

Choose a fundraising target that feels achievable based on the activity or event you're planning to do. Having a target and showing what you're doing can inspire people to donate more. If you surprise yourself and reach your target quickly you can always go higher.



We advise using an online fundraising page, such as JustGiving, as a quick and simple way of collecting sponsorship. It is easy to share your JustGiving page on social media. Having an online fundraising page means that, even if you are just planning to collect cash on the day, people who can't make it to see you in person can still support you.

Social media By using social media sites such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and LinkedIn, you can reach a large audience of family, friends and colleagues with the touch of a button. ## Make the most of your fundraising

Gift Aid

Gift Aid is a scheme which enables UK charities to claim back the tax supporters have paid on their donations from HMRC.

This means that, for every £1 donated, we can receive an extra 25p, without it costing you, our fundraisers, or your supporters, anything more. St. Michael's Hospice can then use this money to make your support worth even more to everyone who benefits from our services. So, whether it enables us to provide an extra cup of tea, an extra hour of care or an extra member of staff on duty, it all adds up!

Many companies throughout the UK offer their employees the chance to boost their fundraising efforts by matching the money they raise.

This is brilliant for the Hospice as it is money for nothing and can raise double the amount of money with very little effort. The companies that offer this will pledge to donate a sum of money relating to the amount their employee has raised to the charity of their choice. Some companies will match fund on a  $\pounds$  for  $\pounds$  basis, and others will stipulate what they can give. Normally, the organisation will set an upper limit.

The best way to get started is to contact your employer and ask if they have a match funding scheme or are interested in setting one up. Alternatively, you could check online first. Once your company has agreed to match fund, they will probably provide you with a request form to complete and a procedure to follow, although each company will be different.
