



Origami Stars

This year we're asking the community to make their own origami stars to remember their loved ones this winter. You can make stars in any size or colour, and even write a special message. We want them to be as unique as your loved ones!

Materials Needed

A4 paper (any colour) Scissors Pen Ruler

Draw lines of varying widths across the A4 paper (widths used in the examples are 1cm, 2cm and 3cm).




Cut along the lines to create strips.



Take one end of the paper and fold it over itself, then place the short tail over the long tail to create a loop.




Take the short tail and feed it through the loop.




Gently pull both tails until the paper folds into a pentagon shape. Press the pentagon flat.








Turn the pentagon over and fold the short tail flat along the pentagon side. Push the short tail through the fold on the back. Trim the excess tail.



Using the long tail, fold it along the side of the pentagon. Keep folding the tail until you have a short end left.



Take the end of the tail and pass it under the flap on the pentagon. Trim the excess.



Gently press in the side of the pentagon to create a corner on each point. Repeat for all 5 sides.



Registered with FUNDRAISING **REGULATOR** Your origami star is finished! Continue making stars until all your strips of paper become stars. The thicker the strips the bigger the star.
